**Happenings at Edenvale!**

Over the years, the CCAF (Collingwood Classic Aircraft Foundation) operated out of Collingwood Airport.

According to Brian Diedenhofen, President of the CCAF, current membership is about 80 members. Every Thursday from 9am to 4pm, a quarter or so of these aviation enthusiasts meet and spent time rebuilding vintage aircraft. In the past 20 years, they have rebuilt a Tiger Moth, champ, and a Fleet Canuck. Currently they are working on a 1943 Stinson (HW 75). Unfortunately, the facilities they were renting at Collingwood were sold last December, leaving the CCAF "homeless". The hunt for a new home was on, and now they are happy to report that they have comfortably settled in at Edenvale, about 10km East of Stayner. Currently the CCAF is occupying about half the space of a 7200sq.ft. hangar, but Edenvale is starting construction of a new 9180sq.ft. hangar. When this is complete, the CCAF will have another 1800sq.ft. available in their existing space.

Edenvale is now listed in the 2006 Canada Flight Supplement, with its new call sign **CNV8** and radio frequency **122.775**. Very soon they will be opening a new restaurant, not only for visiting aircraft but also open for the general public traffic driving by on highway 26, and they have a new cross wind landing strip (grass), 2800' in length, North East by South West!



On Saturday, May 22, Edenvale is hosting their Spring Fly-In, with a complimentary BBQ from 9am-4pm. The CCAF will be there as well, with an open house for all to see their vintage aircraft. Also, don't forget to check out Edenvale's website, www.edenflight.com.

On Saturday, August 5, Edenvale will be hosting the CCAF's annual Gathering of the Classics. Last year, in Collingwood, over 250 aircraft flew in, as well as approximately 3000 visitors by car! The gathering focuses on not only vintage aircraft, but automobiles as well - last year over 60 were on display! The CCAF's website is full of information - take a look - www.classicaircraft.ca.
