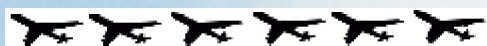

**CO-CAPTAIN's MESSAGE:**

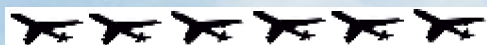

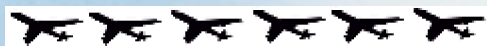
**GUY DOHERTY:**

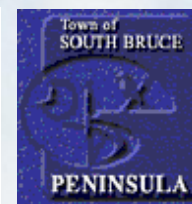
