CO-CAPTAIN's MESSAGE:

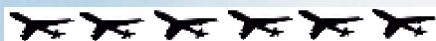
COPA Flight #68 has been very busy during the month of November!

Congratulations and Good Luck!!



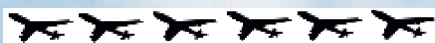

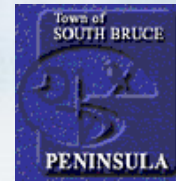
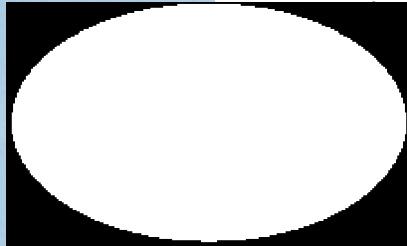
