Over the winter months, we will be sharing with you a few of the reasons you should fly to Wiarnton (CYVV) and, if possible, stay overnight and enjoy "our way of life"!

This month, we would like to introduce you to a wonderful, pilot friendly B&B (*conveniently located within 5 minutes from the airport*), that boasts all the charm of the 19th century, with 21st century amenities.

After a trip to England that included accommodations in a B&B, Owner Danielle Paterson enjoyed the experience so much, she decided she wanted one of her own. Retiring early from her job in the medical field, Danielle started on the path to make her dream a reality. From her home in Port Credit, (*suburb of Toronto*) she was put in touch with a realtor from Owen Sound, who introduced her to the Bruce Peninsula. Having never been to the area before, she was quickly enchanted by its natural beauty and chose to operate her B&B in Wiarnton.

In the 3 1/2 years Danielle has owned the Gadd-About, she has done wonders to restore the interior of the house (*built in 1892*) back to its 19th Century charm, yet has included all the comforts of home. Each room is truly a work of art, complete with furnishings in keeping with the time period of the house. It's like turning the clock back in time! But Danielle wants you to feel completely at home when you are staying with her. Upstairs, there are 4 bedrooms to choose from, a jacuzzi to relax in, a fridge, washer and dryer for your use. Downstairs, guests have full access to the parlour, living room, and dining room - and she urges you to wander around and enjoy the knick-knacks and decor from the early 1900s.

Located at 501 Frank St., the Gadd-About is within walking distance of downtown Wiarnton, Bluewater Park (Colpoy's Bay), Wiarnton Willie's house, and any one of over 10 eating establishments. However, if you arrive late, and the restaurants are closed, Danielle will gladly prepare a meal for you ... or if you need to leave early, she will have your breakfast ready to go!

And yes, Danielle does have an interest in aviation - stemming from her former father-in-law, who was a pilot in WWII, as well as a military and civilian air traffic controller. Because of this, she has included a room for pilots, complete with a computer and high-speed internet - weather and NAV Canada icons on the desktop for quick access. She also has a stranded pilots kit, complete with nightwear, soap, toothbrush, and other small necessities you need if you get stuck away from home.



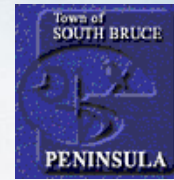
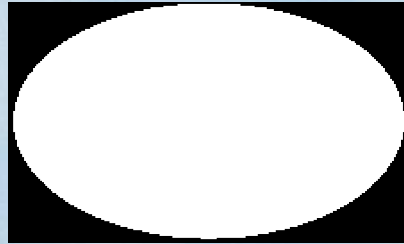
